### **BACKGROUND**

The Northeast states are the eastern-most region of India comprising of eight states Arunachal Padesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura and the host state Sikkim. The region shares more than 4,500 kilometers (2,800 mi) of international border with China in the north, Myanmar in the east, Bangladesh in the southwest, and Bhutan to the northwest. It comprises an area of 262,230 square kilometers (101,250 sq mi), 8.0 percent of India.





The North East Youth Festival is the three-day Festival with a multi-cultural events and a platform for promotion of National Integration with an aim to provide opportunities to young people of the North-Eastern states to interact with each other and get acquainted with different places of cultural interest, language, life style, culinary and sartorial habits, cultural exchange and show case of their talents.

The Gangtok, the beautiful capital of organic Himalayan state Sikkim hosted the 5th edition of North East Youth Festival 2017 which was organized from 28th to 30th October 2017. More than 1200 Youth participants and 200 official and volunteers from all the North East States took part in the Festival. The Festival was organized by Department of Sports & Youth Affairs, Government of Sikkim in Collaboration of Ministry of Youth Affairs, Government of India

However, both these terms have immense significance in issue of national integrity, cultural harmony; mature understanding of each other's needs, aspiration and ambitions. Hon'ble Minister stated that people of Sikkim loves nature, forest and wildlife and it reflect in our tradition. Chief Minister Merit Scholarships Scheme is a unique scheme through which best student are selected through competitive exam each year and sent to the best schools in India. Total 765 students are studying through this scheme since 2010.

The Capacity building and skilling started in 2003-2004 with setting up of State Institute of Capacity Building in 2009 with 20 plus skill areas and have successfully trained 10000 (ten thousand) young men and women and place them in various part of India. In the field of Sports, FIFA U-17 World Cup the Indian team out of 21 member squad 10 players were from North East states including midfielder Komal Tathal of Sikkim. There is good representation from Sikkim in ISL- Bikash Jairu, Nirmal Chettri, Sanju Pradhan, Robin Gurung, Kunzang Lachungpa. Arjun Awadee Tarun Deep Rai is an ace Archer from Sikkim and is selected for training camp for the Olympic Moscow 2018.

Speaking on the Theme of 5th North East Youth Festival "Youth For Organic Farming" Sikkim under the visionary leadership of Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Pawan Chamling has set a benchmark in the world through Organic Farming and has achieve a milestone by 100% conversion of land to organic and become a First Organic State of India. Through this Theme of the Festival, Sikkim state want to send clear message to all the Youth of our nation to live in close proximity of nature, love nature through Organic Farming.


