1. INTRODUCTION –OVERVIEW:

The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, sanctioned Rs. 40,00,000/- Forty lakhs only for four district of Sikkim under the Scheme **SPORTS FOR PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT – KHELO INDIA**. The grant in aid was credited in the Khelo India – Sikkim Youth Development Board, Gangtok, Department of Sports & Youth Affairs account vide reference letter F. No 51-1/MYAS/MDSD/2017 dated 7-6-2018.

The Grant in Aids total Rs. 40,00,000/- @ Rs. 10,00,000 to each four district is meant for Sporting Activities in four districts.

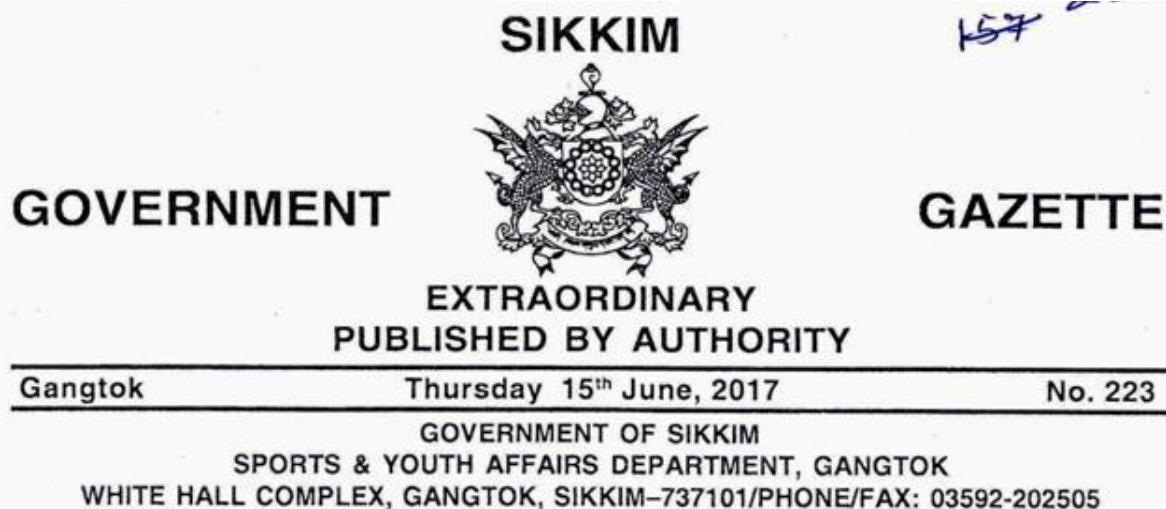
